## Hawk Families:

Welcome to Fall! If you are like me, you are grateful that weather is finally starting to cool off as we approach the end of first quarter. It was nice to see so many families join us at the Family Picnic in September. I would like to thank our incredible Hendricks PTO who organized and coordinated the event. Please remember to **drive slowly and safely** as you drop-off and pick-up students before and after school. They may not run across Camino de la Tierra to meet adults at pick-up – this is very dangerous. Also, please talk with your child about **crossing only in the crosswalk** at the corner and about waiting to cross in front of the school until an adult can escort them across the drop-off zone. Please remember that there is **no parking in the drop-off zones** in front of the school or off of the main parking lot and it is important that you say a quick goodbye and move out of the drop-off area. Please do not wait in your car in the entryway to the school or in the south side loop. Also, do not double park and block in other vehicles. Leaving cars in these areas blocks the thoroughfare, backs up traffic and creates a danger for students as cars try to navigate around them. Please also respect any signs on public roads that state no parking or no standing.

In addition, allow me to remind you about our excellent school meal program. Students can eat breakfast and lunch daily at school. Full price breakfast for children is \$1.00 and lunch is \$2.75. You can add money to your child's account by visiting Quick Links on the Hendricks or Flowing Wells website and selecting "prepay lunch." We encourage ALL families to fill out a free and reduced lunch application online for your child even if you're not sure if you qualify. This allows Hendricks to collect and submit data that qualifies us for grants and special programs and may result in a free or reduced lunch cost <a href="http://FWUSD.NLAPPSCLOUD.com">http://FWUSD.NLAPPSCLOUD.com</a>. Paper copies are available in the office as well.

Lastly, please consider supporting our school with a **tax credit donation**. Tax credit dollars are used for field trips, extra-curricular activities, and school-wide assemblies. Arizona law allows taxpayers to receive a tax credit of up to \$400 per family for donations made to public schools. If you are able to donate, it would make all the difference to our school. Please see the included tax credit form for more details.

Half Day, Noon Dismissal - Friday, October 6<sup>th</sup> for teacher grading. This is the last day of first quarter!

<u>Conferences</u> – Conferences are scheduled for Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, **October 11**<sup>th</sup>, **12**<sup>th</sup>, **and 13**<sup>th</sup>. These days are noon dismissal for students. If you are unable to schedule a conference on one of these days, please contact your child's teacher to schedule a phone conference, or a meeting for a different day.

<u>Awards Assembly</u> - Friday, October 27<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 am for grades 1-2 and 9:30 am for grades 3-6.

## In Mrs. Schiess' class




